How to access and explore the reporting data under the EU Regulation 1143/2014 on invasive alien species (IAS)?

In 2019, Member States had to delivery national reports on invasive alien species as required under Article 24(1) of the invasive alien species regulation.

The IAS portal (<a href="https://ias.eea.europa.eu/">https://ias.eea.europa.eu/</a>) gives the public the possibility to access and explore the data. Different data viewer allows the wider public to analyse:

- IAS of Union concern
- Measures and Impacts
- Permits and Inspections
- Spread patters
- IAS of Member State concern
- Per IAS of Union concern

Via a map viewer, the public can access the distribution of IAS of Union Concern together with the distribution of habitats and species reported under the Nature Directives and the Natura 2000 network.

Moreover, you can find the links to Member State's websites on IAS.
